

## **Sunflower Facts**

- Sunflower is the only flower with flower in its name.
- The scientific name is "Helianthus" Helia for sun an Anthus for flower.
- Sunflowers are the symbol of faith, loyalty and adoration.
- They follow the movement of the sun across the sky from east to west. This process is called heliotropism.
- Oil of sunflower is rich in minerals, calcium and iron contain vitamin A and vitamin D.
- Sunflower is the state flower of Kansas.
- Sunflowers are the fastest growing plants. On an average they grow 8-12 ft. in six months.
- The Guinness world record for the tallest sunflower is 25 feet 5.5 inches in 1986.
- Sunflower with the largest flower head is 32 1/4 inches in diameter.
- A single sunflower can have up to 2000 seeds.
- A sunflower head is made up of 1000 to 2000 Individual ray flowers.
- More than 60 varieties of sunflowers are found around the world.
