A Slow Roll Through Central Virginia

The HCCA consists of cars manufactured before 1916. This unique period of automotive history covers the turn of the century to the end of carriage coachwork, gas lights, hand cranking and profuse use of brass. These early automobiles were called horseless carriages as they were capable of transporting people and freight faster and longer distance without the need of a horse to pull them. Residents enjoyed having the opportunity to look at the cars and learn about them through talking to several of the owners.

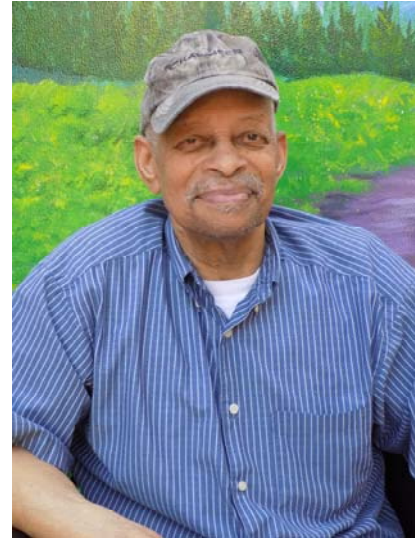


Proper Handwashing
