Proper Hand Washing Techniques

As you touch people, surfaces, and objects throughout the day, you accumulate germs on your hands. You can infect yourself with these germs by touching your eyes, nose, or mouth, or spread them to others. Washing your hands frequently can help limit the transfer of bacteria and viruses.

Always wash your hands:

- When preparing to eat or preparing food
- After using the bathroom
- After blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing
- Also, wash your hands when they are visibly dirty.

It's generally best to wash your hands with soap and water. Here are the steps:

- Wet your hands with clean, running water — either warm or cold.
- Apply soap and lather well.
- Rub your hands vigorously for at least 20 seconds. Remember to scrub all surfaces, including the backs of your hands, wrists, between your fingers and under your fingernails.
- Rinse well.
- Dry your hands with a towel
- Turn water off with a new towel

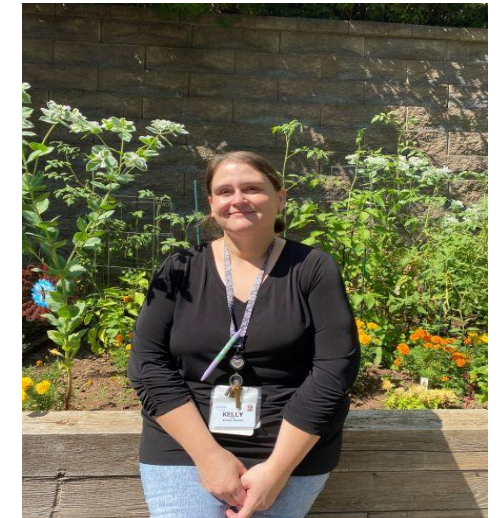
Resident Spotlight
