Do I really need to wash my hands for 20 seconds?

Scientific studies that you need to scrub for 20 seconds to remove harmful germs and chemicals from your hands. If you wash for shorter time, you will not remove as many germs. Make sure to scrub all areas of your hands including your palms, backs of your hands, between your fingers and under your fingernails. Proper handwashing is a very important step in infection control.

Please remember that at this time visitors, including family members are not permitted to eat in the main dining room with other residents. Visitors are encouraged to eat outdoors, arrange to eat in the private dining room or in your loved ones room instead. Face masks are to be worn at all times when not eating.
