Resident Spotlight

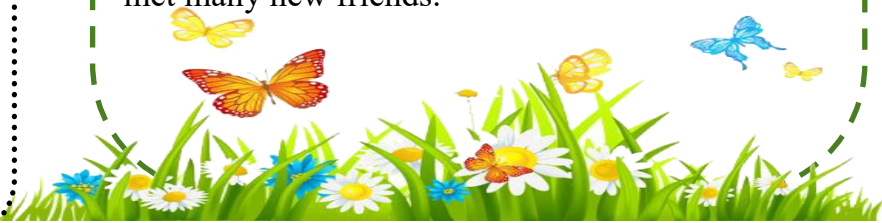
