Interesting Facts About Veterans Day...



- Veterans Day falls on the same day as Remembrance Day and Armistice Day in other countries.
- WWI formally ended on November 11th, at the 11th hour. It is also the 11th month.
- Veterans Day is sometimes confused with Memorial Day, however Memorial Day honors those who died while serving in the military and Veterans Day honors all those who have served in the US military, alive and deceased.
- Veterans Day, November 11th is both a state and federal holiday in the United States.
- There are approximately 24 million veterans living today.
- Each year on Veterans Day there is a ceremony in Arlington Cemetery to honor all who have died in war.
- In 1921, on November 11th, an American soldier was buried at Arlington Cemetery. His identity was unknown and as such, his gravesite is called the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. On November 11th a wreath is laid on the grave during the ceremony. It is laid by the president or by a high-ranking member of the government.
- In 2011 it was estimated that approximately 8.1% of veterans in the United States are woman.





