**HIPAA-** Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 is the United States legislation that provides data privacy and security provisions for safeguarding medical information.

**HIPAA Privacy Rule-**

The Standards for Privacy of Individually Identifiable Health Information, commonly known as the HIPAA Privacy Rule, establishes the first national standards in the United States to protect patients’ personal or health information (PHI).
