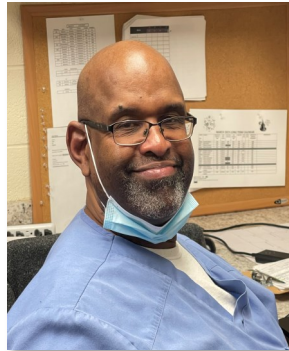

Shamrocks are types of clovers. The name clover usually refers to any plant that has three leaves. In Irish tradition, the three leaves represent faith, hope, and love. The shamrock is a symbol of Irish heritage and culture.
