**As we celebrate Veterans Day, here are some interesting Veteran's Day facts...**

1. In 1918, Moina Michael popularized the idea of wearing a poppy flower in memory of the war dead. She was moved by Lt. Col. McCrae's poem "In Flanders Fields".
2. The American Legion Family passes out paper poppies on Memorial Day and throughout the year to raise funds for veterans. The red poppies serve as a reminder of the sacrifices made by fallen service members.
3. Veteran's Day is also known as Armistice Day which is commemorated every year on Nov 11th to mark the armistice signed.
4. Poppies have a long history of being used to honor the dead, with them having roots in Greek and Roman mythology.
5. In 1903 the Golden Poppy became the state flower of California.
6. Every train in the CPR system in the US and Canada comes to a stop at 11:00am on November 11th to observe a moment of silence followed by one long whistle blast in memory of those who served in the military.

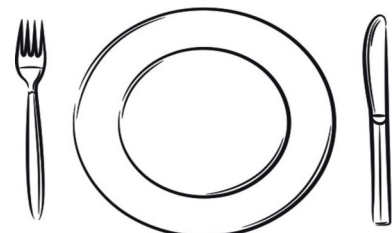
