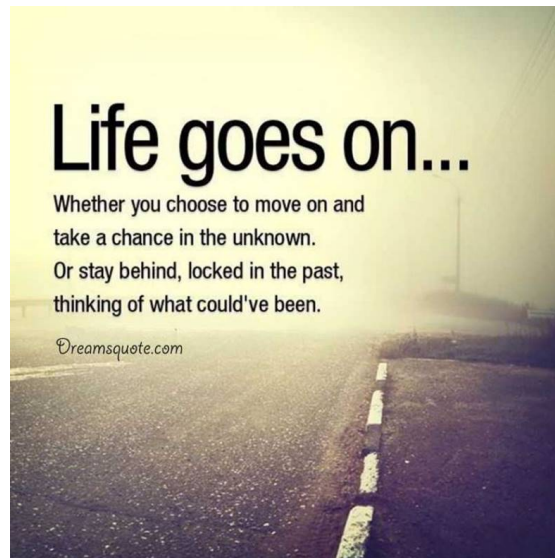


We continue to be COVID-19 free!
