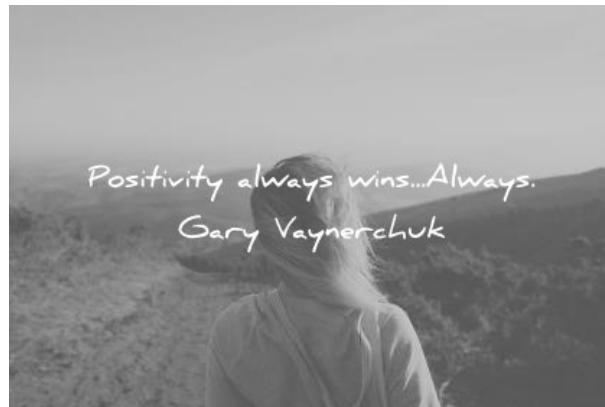


COVID-19 (Week 21) NEWSLETTER

This week's updates are noted below:

- Donations have been received:
 - Mr. & Mrs. Lee Frame donated several cloth masks (THANK YOU).
 - David Kemp with Options brought in 125 written notes from the youth program.
 - Mr. Martin brought in donuts for the team on the 4th of July.
 - JB Cakes donated some pies for the team.
 - Orange Food Bank donated 100 salads for the team.
 - We have received several donations of cloth masks.
- Our testing will occur on July 16th. This is being provided by the National Guard (VANG) once again. Testing is strongly recommended as part of the various phases for reopening nursing and assisted living facilities. Please know that if we have one team member or one resident that tests positive, we are considered to be in an outbreak. It does not mean that we have a major issue within the facility.
- As we continue to be diligent in the protection of our residents and team members, we are finding that we are going through more PPE; however, at this time, we still have a good supply and are receiving same on a regular basis.
- The zipper doors to the rooms on the unit we have designated for COVID seem to be working well, even though we have not had a real need to use them yet. The protective barriers have been very helpful for those residents with dementia that stay in the dayroom areas and won't wear a mask. This affords us the opportunity to observe them, while ensuring their safety.
- It is critical that our residents wear a mask when out of their rooms. Even though we are encouraging everyone to remain in their rooms, we are finding that some residents still come out of their rooms. Anything you can say to your loved one to ensure they are wearing their mask appropriately is needed and greatly

appreciated. As we all know, we are hearing more and more about the value and importance of wearing a mask, properly, for protection. We are explaining to them that they are putting themselves and others at risk by not wearing their mask appropriately. We also ask that they do not go into other residents' rooms. Again, this is for everyone's protection. Thank you for continuing to encourage your loved one to wear a mask.

- REMEMBER—Face Timing/Window Visits with your loved one. Many residents have had the opportunity to speak with their loved ones in this manner.
- Donations of non-perishable food items for our team members are still being accepted.
- Remember, to send our team members a card of thanks. They are truly HEROES and working very hard to keep your loved ones safe.

Thank you all for your continued support and understanding. We appreciate your cooperation with the necessary restrictions. Each day is a new day and we are working toward continued safety for our residents.
